


Airport CityManchester

Airport City Manchester has embarked on a £15million infrastructure investment that will support the development of the landmark £1billion project. Enterprise Way is the first stage of this new development.


The main carriageway is currently under construction as part of the project being delivered by main contractor and Airport City JV partner, Beijing Construction Engineering Group International (BCEGI). The new link road forms a key element of the infrastructure that will connect new development plots to the rest of the landmark site and the wider transport network.

This will help to unlock future development plots across Airport City North. Over the next 10-15 years this will help to facilitate the creation of 1m sq ft of offices, 650,000 sq ft of advanced manufacturing units and 2,400 new hotel beds as well as creating 11,400 new jobs

Enterprise Way Construction impact management

In order to carry out the construction of Enterprise Way, whilst keeping traffic and disturbance to a minimum, certain measures have been put into place to manage impact where possible.

Where traffic disruption is unavoidable, a detailed traffic management plan is being implemented to provide relief. This will include the occasional use of temporary traffic lights and diversions. In addition, a limited amount of night working is also being planned, which allows for an increase in the work that can be completed each day, reducing the total period of time that disruption occurs.

Through collaboration with local partners and representatives, Enterprise Way is being constructed in a responsible manner.

This includes:

- Acting under the supervision of an ecologist to ensure minimal disruption to wildlife
- Protecting local residents by using a good perimeter around the construction zones
- * Employing good construction practices including landscaping $\ensuremath{\mathcal{G}}$ screening to minimise









In addition to the Airport City project, there are other large-scale programmes being undertaken in and around Manchester Airport.

All of these projects will ultimately provide great economic and infrastructure benefit to the area.
